Getting Started

FINISHED SIZE About 10" tall (not including ears or antlers) and 15" circumference.

YARN Cascade Yarns 220 Superwash (100% superwash wool; 220 yd [201 m]/3½ oz [100 g]; ): #862 walnut heather (MC), 1¼ skeins; #856 aporto (blue; CC1), 1 skein; #1926 doeskin heather (CC2), ¼ skein (muzzle and eyelids); #875 feather grey (CC3), small amount (antlers); #910A winter white (CC4), very small amount (eye whites); #1913 jet (CC5), very small amount (nose and mouth embroidery).

HOOK Size E/4 (3.5 mm). Adjust hook size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

NOTIONS Stitch markers (m); yarn needle; pins; size 21 mm safety eyes with gold iris and round pupil, purchased at www.GlassEyesOnline.com; polyester fiberfill; embroidery needle and embroidery floss for nose (DMC #842 very light beige).

GAUGE 19 sts and 22 rnds = 4" in sc; Rnds 1–6 of body = 2" diameter.

Notes

Body is worked top down in the rnd, setting aside sts to be worked later for arms and changing color for pants. Body is divided to work right leg first, and then left leg, changing color for feet. Tops of feet are worked in turned rows. Foot bottoms, eye whites, ears, muzzle, and antlers are all worked separately then sewn to body.

Gauge is not crucial but must be tight to hide stuffing. If you can see holes bet your sts in your swatch, use a smaller hook.

Stitch Guide

Double crochet five together (dc5tog):

[Yo, insert hook in next st, yo and pull up lp, yo, draw through 2 lps] 5 times (6 lps on hook), yo, draw through all lps on hook—4 sts dec'd.

Half double crochet five together

(hdc5tog): [Yo, insert hook in next st, yo and pull up lp] 5 times (11 lps on hook), yo, draw through all lps on hook—4 sts dec'd.

Pattern

BODY

Note: Use st m to keep track of first st of rnd. With MC, make an adjustable ring (see Glossary).

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, do not join—6 sts.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around—12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] 6 times—18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times—24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 6 times—30 sts.

Rnd 6: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—36 sts.

Rnd 7: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts] 6 times—42 sts.

Rnd 8: [Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 6 times—48 sts.

Rnd 9: [Sc in next 11 sts, 2 sc in next st] 4 times—52 sts.

Rnd 10: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts] 4 times—56 sts.

Rnd 11: [Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts] 4 times—60 sts.

Rnd 12: [2 sc in next st, sc in next 19 sts] 3 times—63 sts.

Rnd 13: [Sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts] 3 times—66 sts.

Rnd 14: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 18 sts] 3 times—69 sts.

Rnd 15: [Sc in next 20 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 3 times—72 sts.

Rnds 16–26: Sc around. Do not fasten off.

Shape shoulders:

Rnd 27: Sc in next 17 sts, 3 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 34 sts, 3 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 17 sts—80 sts.

Rnd 28: Sc in next 19 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 38 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 19 sts—84 sts.

Rnd 29: Sc in next 20 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 40 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 20 sts—88 sts.

Rnd 30: Sc around.

Rnd 31: Sc in next 21 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 42 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 21 sts—92 sts.

Rnd 32 (armholes): Sc in next 20 sts, sk next 10 sts for left arm, place marker (pm) in first sk st, sc in next 36 sts, sk next 10 sts for right arm, pm in first sk st, sc in next 16 sts—72 sts, not including sk sts.

Rnds 33–36: Sc around. Do not fasten off. Leave body to work eye.

Eye (make 2):

EYE WHITE:

With CC4, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; tighten lp leaving enough space for safety eye shank.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around, sl st in first sc to join—12 sts. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

EYELID:

With CC2, ch 7.

Row 1: (RS) Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st, sl st in next st, turn—8 sts.

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

EYELID EDGING:

With MC and eyelid RS facing, join yarn in back lp of first st of Row 2. Ch 1, sl st in each st in back lp only (blo)—8 sl sts. Fasten off, leaving long tail.

Attach eyes as foll: Place eyes on opposite side

of head from where your last body st was made. Place eye whites on body bet Rows 20 and 21 from top of head, 14 sts apart. Push safety eye shank through eye white first, then the body. There should be about 11 sts from eye post to top of shoulder. When you are happy with placement of eyes, apply washers to eye shank inside head. Give eyes a good tug to ensure that they are securely fastened before cont.

Cont body:

PANTS:

Rnd 37: Sc in next 2 sts; new beg of rnd. Fasten off MC. Join CC1 in next st, sl st in next st (counts as first st of rnd), sl st in next 71 sts, take lp off hook, insert hook from WS to RS under first sl st of rnd, place live lp back on hook and pull lp through to WS of work—72 sl sts.

Rnd 38: Working behind sl sts, sc in each MC sc of Rnd 36—72 sts.

Rnds 39–44: Sc around.

Rnd 45: [Sc in next 22 sts, sc2tog (see Glossary)] 3 times—69 sts rem.

Rnd 46: [Sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 11 sts] 3 times—66 sts rem.

Rnd 47: [Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 16 sts] 3 times—63 sts rem.

Rnd 48: [Sc in next 15 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts] 3 times—60 sts rem.

Rnd 49: [Sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts] 6 times—54 sts rem.

Rnd 50: [Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts] 6 times—48 sts rem. Sc in next st; new beg of rnd. Do not fasten off. Stuff body firmly with polyester fiberfill and cont to stuff as you go along.

RIGHT LEG:

Rnd 51: Ch 8 (leg divider), sk next 24 sts, pm in first sk st (beg of left leg), [sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts] 4 times, sc in each ch of beg ch-8, ending at front of pants—28 sts. Pm for new beg of rnd.

Rnds 52–58: Sc around.

Rnd 59: Sl st around. Take lp off hook, insert hook from WS to RS under first sl st of rnd, place live lp back on hook and pull lp through to WS of work. Join MC with yo and pull through. Tug on CC1 tail to tighten lp until it disappears. Fasten off CC1.

Rnd 60: Working behind sl sts in CC1 sc of Rnd 58, sc in next 2 sts, [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 4 times, sc in next 18 sts—32 sts.

Rnds 61–62: Sc around. Do not fasten off.

Right foot top:

Row 1: (RS) Sc in next 15 sts, turn.

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, sc in next 12 sts, turn.

Rows 3–5: Rep Row 2.

Row 6: (WS) Ch 1, sc in next st, [5 hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 3 times, 5 hdc in next st, sc in next st, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in next st, [dc5tog (see Stitch Guide), sc in next 2 sts] 3 times, dc5tog, sc in next st.

Foot edging:

With RS facing, rotate top of foot to cont work along end of rows as foll: 6 sc along side edge of foot, sc in next 17 sts around the back of foot, remove beg-of- rnd m, sc in next 3 sts of Row 1, then 6 sc along other side edge of foot, sl st in first sc to join—32 sts around foot. Fasten off.

Left leg:

Rnd 1: Join CC1 in marked st for left leg. Ch 1, beg with marked st, [sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts] 4 times, sc in next 8 sts between legs—28 sts.

Rnds 2–8: Sc around.

Sc 13; new beg of rnd. Cont to work as for right leg beg with Rnd 59.

Left foot top:

Work as for right foot top.

Right arm:

Note: Leave beg tail dangling on outside of work.

Join MC in marked st for right arm.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in next 10 sk sts, 2 sc in armpit—12 sts.

Rnds 2–3: Sc around.

Rnd 4: 2 sc in first st, sc in each rem st—1 st inc'd.

Rnds 5–11: Rep Rnd 4—20 sts.

Thumb:

Rnd 12: Sc in next 4 sts (thumb location), 5 hdc in next st, sc in next 15 sts—24 sts.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 4 sts, hdc5tog (see *Stitch Guide*), sc in next 15 sts—20 sts rem.

Rnds 14–15: Sc around. Do not fasten off.

Fingers:

Row 1: (RS) Sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Row 2: (WS) Ch1, sc in next st, [5 hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 2 times, 5 hdc in next st, sc in next st, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, [dc5tog, sc in next 2 sts] 2 times, dc5tog, sc in next st, sl st in next st to fasten off, leaving long tail. Stuff arm. Use end tail to sew palm of hand. Use beg tail to close any small holes where yarn was joined for arm.

Left arm:

Join MC in marked st for left arm.

Rnds 1–11: Work as for right arm—20 sts.

Thumb:

Rnd 12: Sc in next 10 sts (thumb location), 5 hdc in next st, sc in next 9 sts—24 sts.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 10 sts, dc5tog, sc in next 9 sts—20 sts rem.

Rnds 14–15: Sc around. Do not fasten off.

Fingers:

Row 1: (RS) Sc in next 2 sts, turn.

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, sc in next st, [5 hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 2 times, 5 hdc in next st, sc in next st, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, [dc5tog, sc in next 2 sts] 2 times, dc5tog, sc in next st, sl st in next st to fasten off, leaving long tail. Stuff arm. Use end tail to sew palm of hand. Use beg tail to close any small holes where yarn was joined for arm.

FOOT BOTTOMS (MAKE 2)

With MC, ch 5.

Row 1: Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 sts, turn—4 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, turn—6 sts.

Rows 3–4: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, turn—8 sts.

Rows 6–9: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, turn—10 sts.

Rows 11–13: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st—12 sts. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, rotate foot bottom to work along end of rows as foll: 12 sc along side edge of foot bottom, 2 sc in first st across heel, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, 12 sc along other side edge of foot bottom, sl st in first sc to join—30 sts. Fasten off, leaving long tail.

ANTLERS (MAKE 2)

With CC3 and leaving long tail, ch 12, join to form a ring—12 ch.

Rnd 1: [Sc in next st, sc2tog] 4 times, do not join—8 sts rem.

Rnd 2: Sc around.

Rnd 3: Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts—10 sts.

Rnd 4: Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts—12 sts.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts—14 sts.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 4 sts, sk next 6 sts, sc in next 4 sts—8 sts rem, not including sk sts.

Rnds 7–8: Sc around.

Rnd 9: Sc in next st, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts—10 sts.

Rnd 10: Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts—12 sts.

Rnd 11: Sc in next st, sk next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts—6 sts rem, not including sk sts.

Rnds 12–14: Sc around. Fasten off.

Tines: Join yarn to a sk st. Leave beg tail dangling on outside of work.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same st and around sk st section—6 sts.

Rnd 2: 1 sc in each st around—6 sts.. Fasten off. Rep for 2nd tine.

FINISHING:

Stuff antlers with polyester fiberfill using eraser-end of pencil to stuff fiberfill to ends if necessary. Close tip of each tine by weaving tail with yarn needle through front lp of each rem st around opening. Weave in all ends except for long beg tail.

EAR (MAKE 2)

Inner ear:

With CC2, ch 17.

Row 1: Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, beg with first st in 2nd ch from hook, [sc2tog] 8 times, turn—8 sts rem.

Rows 2–17: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 18: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, turn—6 sts rem.

Row 19: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—4 sts rem.

Row 21: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 2 times, turn—2 sts rem.

Row 22: Ch 1, sc2tog—1 st rem. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, rotate inner ear to work along end of rows as foll: 16 sc along side of ear, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts along bottom edge of ear, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sts in each of last 2 sts along bottom edge of ear, 16 sc along other side of ear, ending at tip of ear—52 sts. Fasten off.

Outer Ear:

With MC, ch 21.

Row 1: Working in bottom lp of ch, beg with first st in 2nd ch from hook, [sc2tog] 10 times, turn—10 sts rem.

Rows 2–17: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 18: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog, turn—8 sts rem.

Row 19: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, turn—6 sts rem.

Row 21: Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 22: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—4 sts rem.

Row 23: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 2 times, turn—2 sts rem.

Row 24: Ch 1, sc2tog—1 st rem. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, rotate outer ear to work along end of rows as foll: 16 sc along side of ear, sc in next 20 sts across bottom edge of ear, 16 sc along other side of ear, ending at tip of ear—52 sts. Do not fasten off.

Assembly:

Center inner ear on top of outer ear, lining up bottom edges. Beg at tip of ear, sl st the two layers tog along edges, through the back lp only of inner ear, and under both lps of outer ear. Fasten off. Form base of ear into a tube. Using an 18" long strand of MC, beg about $\frac{3}{4}$ " from bottom edge of ear, sew tube close to bottom edge. Leave tail for sewing ear to head.

MUZZLE

With CC2, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, do not join.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around—12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—18 sts.

Rnd 4: Sc around.

Rnd 5: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times—24 sts.

Rnd 6: Sc around. Fasten off, leaving long tail.

FINISHING

Finish stuffing body and legs. Using yarn needle and tails, sew foot bottoms to feet. Pin muzzle in place (use images as guide for placement). Using tail ends and yarn needle, sew around edge of muzzle to secure to face. Pin eyelids to eyes, adjusting angle of eyelids to give you desired expression. Sew eyelids in place using tails. Pin ears and antlers to top of head, spreading out bottom circumference of ears and antlers for a wide base to prevent them from flopping back and forth. Using yarn needle and tails, sew ears and antlers to head. Weave in all ends, using yarn ends to close any small holes in fabric where yarn was joined. Using embroidery needle and floss, satin-stitch (see Glossary) a triangle for a nose on the muzzle. Using CC5, outline the sides of nose and embroider mouth. Tail: Using MC and CC2, make a 2" pom pom (see Glossary). Using yarn needle and the strand of MC that was used to tie the center of the pom pom, sew pom pom to pants about 4 rnds down from top edge of pants. Weave in ends. 🌸

Concentration Ratings:


- 1 2 3 4 **LITTLE CONCENTRATION REQUIRED.**
Straightforward stitching means your hands can work on autopilot.
- 1 2 3 4 **SOME CONCENTRATION REQUIRED.**
Easily memorized stitch patterns and minimal shaping might require some focus and counting.
- 1 2 3 4 **FAIR AMOUNT OF FOCUS REQUIRED.**
Involved stitch patterns, shaping, or assembly require fairly constant concentration.
- 1 2 3 4 **EXTREME FOCUS REQUIRED.**
Unusual techniques or complex stitch patterns and shaping require constant focus.

ADJUSTABLE RING

Place slipknot on hook, leaving a 4" tail. Wrap tail around fingers to form ring. Work stitches of first round into ring. At end of first round, pull tail to tighten ring.


POM-POM

Cut two circles of cardboard, each $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3 cm) larger than desired finished pom-pom width. Cut a small circle out of the center and a small edge out of the side of each circle (Figure 1). Tie a strand of yarn between the circles, hold circles together and wrap with yarn—the more wraps, the thicker the pom-pom. Cut between the circles and knot the tie strand tightly (Figure 2). Place pom-pom between two smaller cardboard circles held together with a needle and trim the edges (Figure 3). This technique comes from *Nicky Epstein's Knitted Embellishments*, Interweave Press, 1999.



SATIN STITCH

Work closely spaced straight stitches, in graduated lengths as desired, entering and exiting in the center of or at the side of the crocheted stitches.



SINGLE CROCHET TWO TOGETHER (SC2TOG)

Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop (2 loops on hook, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook—1 stitch decreased.

Getting Started

FINISHED SIZE 18 (19½, 20½, 22)" head circumference. Sized for small child (large child, adult small, adult medium). Sample shown measures 22".

YARN Cascade Yarns 220 Superwash (100% superwash wool; 220 yd [201 m]/3½ oz [100 g]; **(4)**): #862 walnut heather (MC), 1 (1, 2, 2) skeins; #1926 doeskin heather (CC1), ¼ skein (muzzle and eyelids); #875 feather grey (CC2), small amount (antlers); #910A winter white (CC3), very small amount (eye whites); #1913 jet (CC4), very small amount (pupils, and nose and mouth embroidery).

HOOK Hat: Size F/5 (3.75 mm). Sewn-on pieces: D/3 (3.25 mm) for sizes 18 (19½)", E/4 (3.5 mm) for sizes 20½ (22)". Adjust hook size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

NOTIONS Stitch markers (m); yarn needle; embroidery needle and embroidery floss for nose (DMC #842 very light beige); pins; head form, or balloon and large coffee mug for blocking and feature placement.

GAUGE 18½ sts and 22½ rnds = 4" in sc with larger hook; Rnds 1–10 of hat = 4" diameter with larger hook.

Notes

Hat is worked top down in joined turned rnds. Earflaps and ties are worked in turned rows. Antlers, ears, eyes and muzzle are made separately and sewn on hat.

All odd rnds/rows are RS and all even rnds/rows are WS on Hat portion of pattern.

Stitch Guide

Single crochet three together (sc3tog):

[Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up lp] 3 times (4 lps on hook), yo, draw through all lps on hook—2 sts dec'd.

Pattern

HAT

With MC and larger hook, make an adjustable ring (see Glossary).

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, sl st in first sc to join, turn—6 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, sl st in first sc to join, turn—12 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—18 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—24 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—30 sts.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—36 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,

sc in next 3 sts] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—42 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, [sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—48 sts.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—54 sts.

Sizes 20½ (22)" only:

Rnd 10: Ch 1, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts] 6 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—60 sts.

All sizes:

Rnd 10 (10, 11, 11): Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, sc in next 17 (17, 19, 19) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—57 (57, 63, 63) sts.

Rnd 11 (11, 12, 12): Ch 1, [sc in next 9 (9, 10, 10) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 (9, 10, 10) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—60 (60, 66, 66) sts.

Rnd 12 (12, 13, 13): Ch 1, [sc in next 4 (4, 5, 5) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 (15, 16, 16) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—63 (63, 69, 69) sts.

Rnd 13 (13, 14, 14): Ch 1, [sc in next 5 (5, 6, 6) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 (15, 16, 16) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—66 (66, 72, 72) sts.

Rnd 14 (14, 15, 15): Ch 1, [sc in next 2 (2, 3, 3) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 19 (19, 20, 20) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—69 (69, 75, 75) sts.

Rnd 15 (15, 16, 16): Ch 1, [sc in next 2 (2, 3, 3) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 20 (20, 21, 21) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—72 (72, 78, 78) sts.

Rnd 16 (16, 17, 17): Ch 1, [sc in next 9 (9, 10, 10) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 14 (14, 15, 15) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—75 (75, 81, 81) sts.

Rnd 17 (17, 18, 18): Ch 1, [sc in next 9 (9, 10, 10) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 (15, 16, 16) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—78 (78, 84, 84) sts.

Rnd 18 (18, 19, 19): Ch 1, [sc in next 4 (4, 5, 5) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 21 (21, 22, 22) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—81 (81, 87, 87) sts.

Rnd 19 (19, 20, 20): Ch 1, [sc in next 5 (5, 6, 6) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 21 (21, 22, 22) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—84 (84, 90, 90) sts.

Sizes 19½ (20½, 22)" only:

Rnd 20 (21, 21): Ch 1, [sc in next 11 (12, 12) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 (17, 17) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—87 (93, 93) sts.

Rnd 21 (22, 22): Ch 1, [sc in next 11 (12, 12) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 17 (18, 18) sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—90 (96, 96) sts.

Size 22" only:

Rnd 23: Ch 1, [sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 23 sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—99 sts.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, [sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 23 sts] 3 times, sl st in first sc to join, turn—102 sts.

All sizes:

Rnds 20–32 (22–34, 23–36, 25–38): Ch 1, sc around, sl st in first sc to join, turn—84 (90, 96, 102) sts. Do not fasten off.

Earflaps:

Worked in turned rows.

Row 1: (RS) Ch 1, sc2tog (see Glossary), sc in next 59 (63, 68, 72) sts, sc2tog, leave rem 21 (23, 24, 26) sts unworked, turn—61 (65, 70, 74) sts rem.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—2 sts dec'd.

Rows 3–4: Rep Row 2—55 (59, 64, 68) sts rem.

Sizes 20½ (22)" only:

Rows 5–6: Rep Row 2—60 (62) sts rem.

All sizes:

Left earflap:

Row 5 (5, 7, 7): (RS) Ch 1, sc in next 18 (19, 21, 22) sts, sc2tog, leaving rem 35 (38, 37, 38) sts unworked, turn—19 (20, 22, 23) sts rem.

Row 6 (6, 8, 8): (WS) Rep Row 2—17 (18, 20, 21) sts rem.

Row 7 (7, 9, 9): Ch 1, sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—1 st dec'd.

Rows 8–14 (8–14, 10–18, 10–18): Rep Row 7 (7, 9, 9)—9 (10, 10, 11) sts rem.

Row 15 (15, 19, 19): Ch 1, sc2tog 0 (1, 1, 1) time(s), sc in next 7 (6, 6, 7) sts, sc2tog, turn—8 (8, 8, 9) sts rem.

Row 16 (16, 20, 20): Ch 1, sc2tog 0 (1, 1, 1) time(s), sc in next 6 (4, 4, 5) sts, sc2tog, turn—7 (6, 6, 7) sts rem.

Row 17 (17, 21, 21): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 3 (2, 2, 3) sts, sc2tog, turn—5 (4, 4, 5) sts rem.

Row 18 (18, 22, 22): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 1 (0, 0, 1) st(s), sc2tog, turn—3 (2, 2, 3) sts rem.

Row 19 (19, 23, 23): Ch 1, sc3tog (see Stitch Guide) (sc2tog, sc2tog, sc3tog), ending with a RS row—1 st rem. Do not turn. Do not fasten off.

Right earflap:

With RS still facing you, rotate hat to work along back edge of left earflap.

Row 1: (RS) Sc 15 (15, 16, 16) evenly spaced along back edge of left earflap, sc in next 35 (38, 37, 38) sts, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 15 (16, 18, 19) sts, sc2tog—17 (18, 20, 21) sts rem.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 15 (16, 18, 19) sts—16 (17, 19, 20) sts.

Rows 4–10 (4–10, 4–12, 4–12): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in rem sts across—9 (10, 10, 11) sts rem.

Row 11 (11, 13, 13): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 7 (6, 6, 7) sts, sc2tog 0 (1, 1, 1) time(s)—8 (8, 8, 9) sts rem.

Row 12 (12, 14, 14): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 6 (4, 4, 5) sts, sc2tog 0 (1, 1, 1) time(s)—7 (6, 6, 7) sts rem.

Row 13 (13, 15, 15): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 3 (2, 2, 3) sts, sc2tog—5 (4, 4, 5) sts rem.

Row 14 (14, 16, 16): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 1

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(0, 0, 1) st(s), sc2tog—3 (2, 2, 3) sts rem.
Row 15 (15, 17, 17): Ch 1, sc3tog (sc2tog, sc2tog, sc3tog)—1 st rem. Do not turn. Do not fasten off.

Ties and edging:

Ch 39 (41, 43, 45).

Next row: (RS) Working in bottom lp of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across—38 (40, 42, 44) sts. With RS still facing you, rotate hat to work along front edge of right earflap as foll: sc 18 (18, 20, 20) evenly spaced along front edge of right earflap, sc in next 21 (23, 24, 26) sts across front of hat, sc 18 (18, 20, 20) evenly spaced along front edge of left earflap, ch 39 (41, 43, 45), working in bottom lp of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, sl st to fasten off—38 (40, 42, 44) sts.

Right back earflap edging:

With MC and RS facing, sl st to join in last sc of back edge. Sc 15 (15, 16, 16) along back edge of right earflap. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

ANTLERS (MAKE 2)

With CC2 and smaller hook, leaving long tail, ch 16, join to form a ring.

Rnd 1: [Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog] 4 times, do not join—12 sts rem.

Rnds 2–4 (2–5, 2–6, 2–6): Sc around.

Rnd 5 (6, 7, 7): Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts—14 sts.

Rnd 6 (7, 8, 8): Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts—16 sts.

Rnd 7 (8, 9, 9): Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts—18 sts.

Rnd 8 (9, 10, 10): Sc in next 5 sts, sk next 8 sts, sc in next 5 sts—10 sts rem, not including sk sts.

Rnds 9–10 (10–12, 11–13, 11–13): Sc around.

Rnd 11 (13, 14, 14): Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts—12 sts.

Rnd 12 (14, 15, 15): Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts—14 sts.

Rnd 13 (15, 16, 16): Sc in next 2 sts, sk next 6 sts, sc in next 6 sts—8 sts rem, not including sk sts.

Rnds 14–17 (16–19, 17–21, 17–22): Sc

around. Fasten off.

Tines:

Join yarn with sl st to a skipped st. Leave beg tail dangling on outside of work.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same st and around sk st section—8 sts.

Rep Rnd 1 two (two, three, four) more times. Fasten off. Rep for 2nd tine.

Finishing:

Stuff antlers with polyester fiberfill using eraser-end of pencil if necessary. Close tip of each tine by weaving tail with yarn needle through front l of each rem st around opening. Weave in all tails except for long beg tail.

EAR (MAKE 2)

Inner ear:

With CC1 and smaller hook, ch 17.

Row 1: Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, beg with first st in 2nd ch from hook, [sc2tog] 8 times, turn—8 sts rem.

Rows 2–19 (2–19, 2–21, 2–21): Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 20 (20, 22, 22): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, turn—6 sts rem.

Row 21 (21, 23, 23): Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 22 (22, 24, 24): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—4 sts rem.

Row 23 (23, 25, 25): Ch 1, [sc2tog] 2 times—2 sts rem.

Row 24 (24, 26, 26): Ch 1, sc2tog—1 st rem. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, rotate inner ear to work along end of rows. Sc 19 (19, 20, 20) along side of ear, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts along bottom edge of ear, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sts in each of last 2 sts along bottom edge of ear, sc 19 (19, 20, 20) along other side of ear, ending at tip of ear. Fasten off.

Outer ear:

With MC and smaller hook, ch 21.

Row 1: Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, beg with first st in 2nd ch from hook, [sc2tog] 10 times, turn—10 sts rem.

Rows 2–19 (2–19, 2–21, 2–21): Ch 1, sc

around, turn.

Row 20 (20, 22, 22): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog, turn—8 sts rem.

Row 21 (21, 23, 23): Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 22 (22, 24, 24): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, turn—6 sts rem.

Row 23 (23, 25, 25): Ch 1, sc around, turn.

Row 24 (24, 26, 26): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—4 sts rem.

Row 25 (25, 27, 27): Ch 1, [sc2tog] 2 times, turn—2 sts rem.

Row 26 (26, 28, 28): Ch 1, sc2tog—1 st rem. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, rotate outer ear to work in ends of rows. Sc 19 (19, 20, 20) along side of ear, sc in next 20 sts across bottom edge of ear, sc 19 (19, 20, 20) along other side of ear, ending at tip of ear. Do not fasten off.

Assembly:

Center inner ear on top of outer ear, lining up bottom edges. Beg at tip of ear, sl st the two layers tog along edges, through the back lp only (blo) of inner ear, and under both lps of outer ear. Fasten off.

Form base of ear into a tube. Using an 18" long strand of MC, beg about ¼" from bottom edge of ear, sew bottom edge of ear into a tube. Leave tail for sewing ear to hat.

EYE (MAKE 2)

Eye whites:

With CC3 and smaller hook, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, do not join.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around—12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times—24 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Eyelid:

With CC1 and smaller hook, ch 9.

Row 1: (RS) Working in bottom ridge lp of ch, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sl st in next st, turn—8 sts rem.

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off, leaving long tail.

EYELID EDGING:

With CC4 and smaller hook, RS facing, join yarn in back lp of first st of foundation ch. Ch 1, sl st in blo of each ch—8 sl sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Pupil:

With CC4 and smaller hook, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, do not join.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around—12 sts.

Rnd 3: Insert hook in back lp of first st of rnd, with MC, yo and pull up lp, sl st in next and each of next 11 sts blo—11 sts rem. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Using yarn needle, thread yarn end under both lps of first sl st of rnd. Push needle down through sl st edging in bet the two lps of last sl st made for an invisible join.

MUZZLE

With CC1 and smaller hook, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, do not join.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around—12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times—24 sts.

Rnd 5: Sc around.

Rnd 6: [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 6 times—30 sts.

Rnd 7: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—36 sts.

Rnd 8: Sc around.

Rnd 9: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts] 6 times—42 sts.

Sizes 19½ (20½, 22)" only:

Rnd 10: [Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times—48 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

Spray-block hat if desired, using head form or a balloon resting on a coffee mug. Find center line of hat by folding in half. Mark center line with thread or pins. While hat is resting on

head-block or balloon, carefully pin muzzle and eye whites in place on front of hat. You can place all of the features all at once to help you space things, or you can stop here and sew the eye whites and muzzle to hat before continuing. Using yarn needle and tails, sew around edge of each eye white and muzzle to secure to hat. Pin pupils to eyes, placing them just slightly off center toward the midline of face. With MC tail, sew around edge of pupil to attach to eye white. Pin eyelids to eyes, adjusting angle of eyelids to give you desired expression. Sew eyelids in place using tails. Pin ears and antlers to top of hat, spreading out bottom circumference of ears and antlers for a wide base to prevent them from flopping back and forth. Using yarn needle and tails, sew ears and antlers to hat. Weave in all ends. Using embroidery needle and floss, satin-stitch (see Glossary) a triangle for a nose on the muzzle. Using CC4, outline the sides of nose and embroider mouth. ❁

Concentration Ratings:



LITTLE CONCENTRATION REQUIRED.

Straightforward stitching means your hands can work on autopilot.



SOME CONCENTRATION REQUIRED.

Easily memorized stitch patterns and minimal shaping might require some focus and counting.



FAIR AMOUNT OF FOCUS REQUIRED.

Involved stitch patterns, shaping, or assembly require fairly constant concentration.



EXTREME FOCUS REQUIRED.

Unusual techniques or complex stitch patterns and shaping require constant focus.

ADJUSTABLE RING

Place slipknot on hook, leaving a 4" tail. Wrap tail around fingers to form ring. Work stitches of first round into ring. At end of first round, pull tail to tighten ring.

SATIN STITCH

Work closely spaced straight stitches, in graduated lengths as desired, entering and exiting in the center of or at the side of the crocheted stitches.



SINGLE CROCHET TWO TOGETHER (SC2TOG)

Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop (2 loops on hook), insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook—1 stitch decreased.

SINGLE CROCHET THREE TOGETHER (SC3TOG)

[Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over, pull loop through stitch] 3 times (4 loops on hook). Yarn over and draw yarn through all 4 loops on hook. Completed sc3tog—2 stitches decreased.
